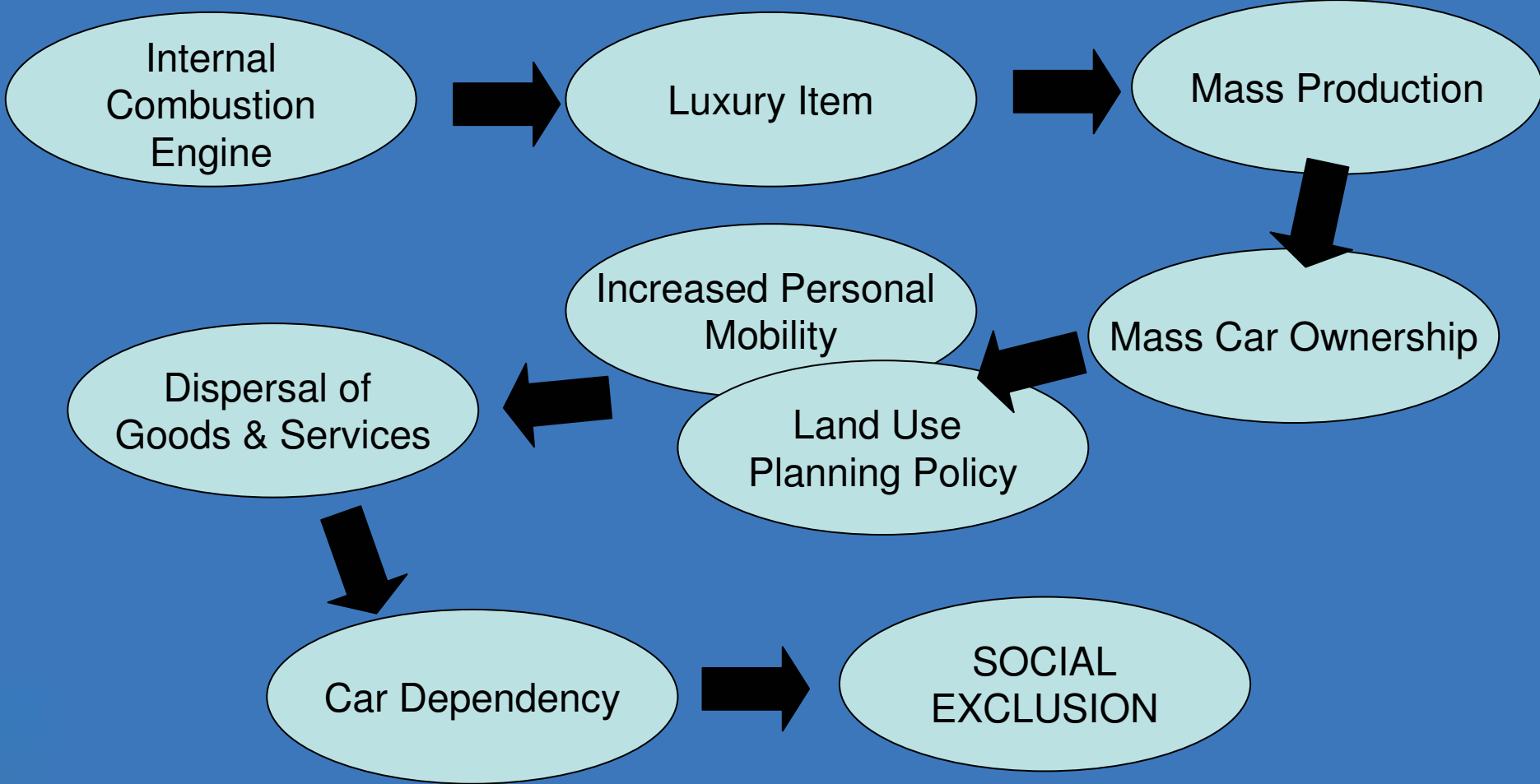

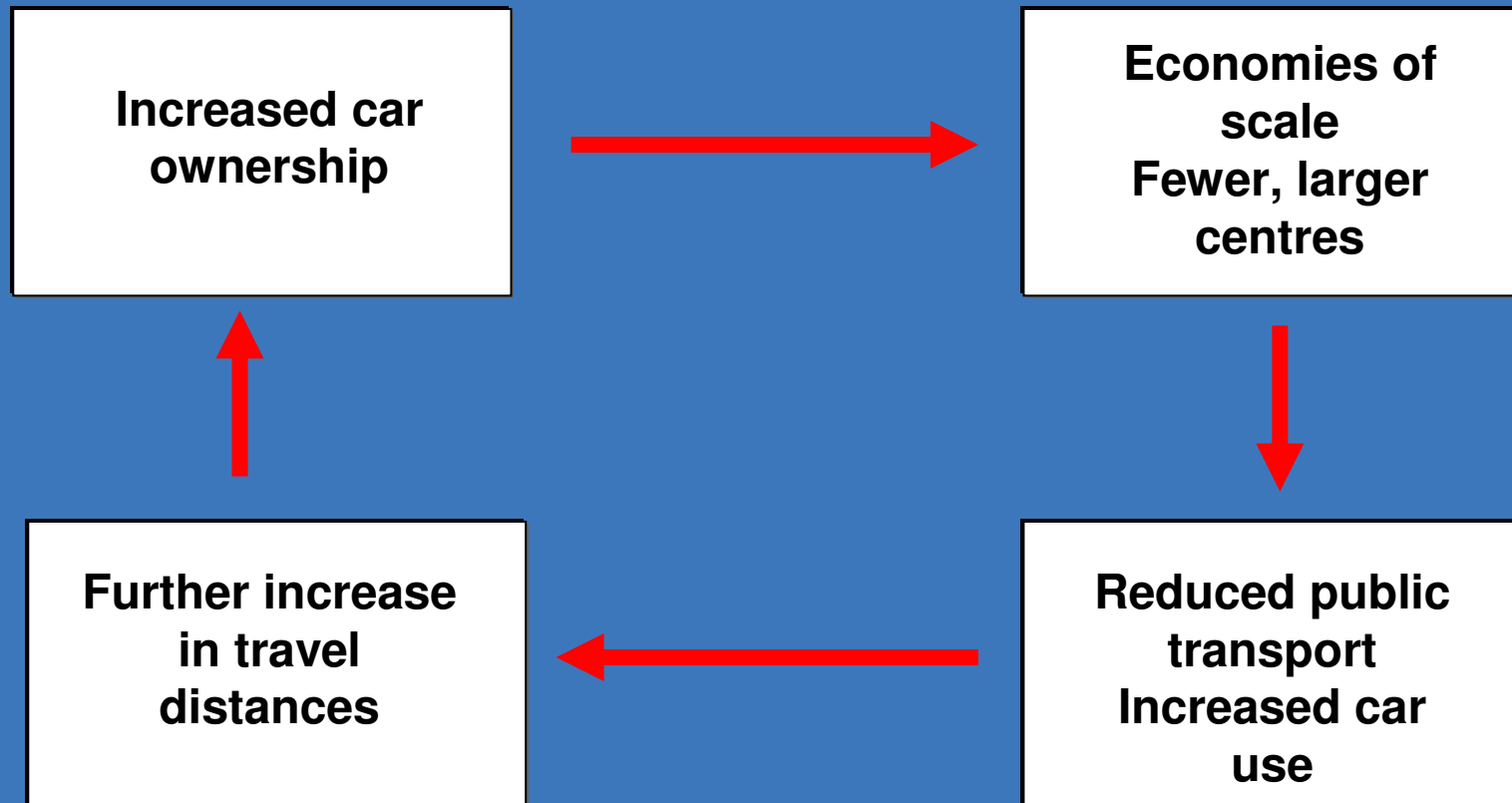
Car Ownership

Approx. 40% of European Union households do not have a car

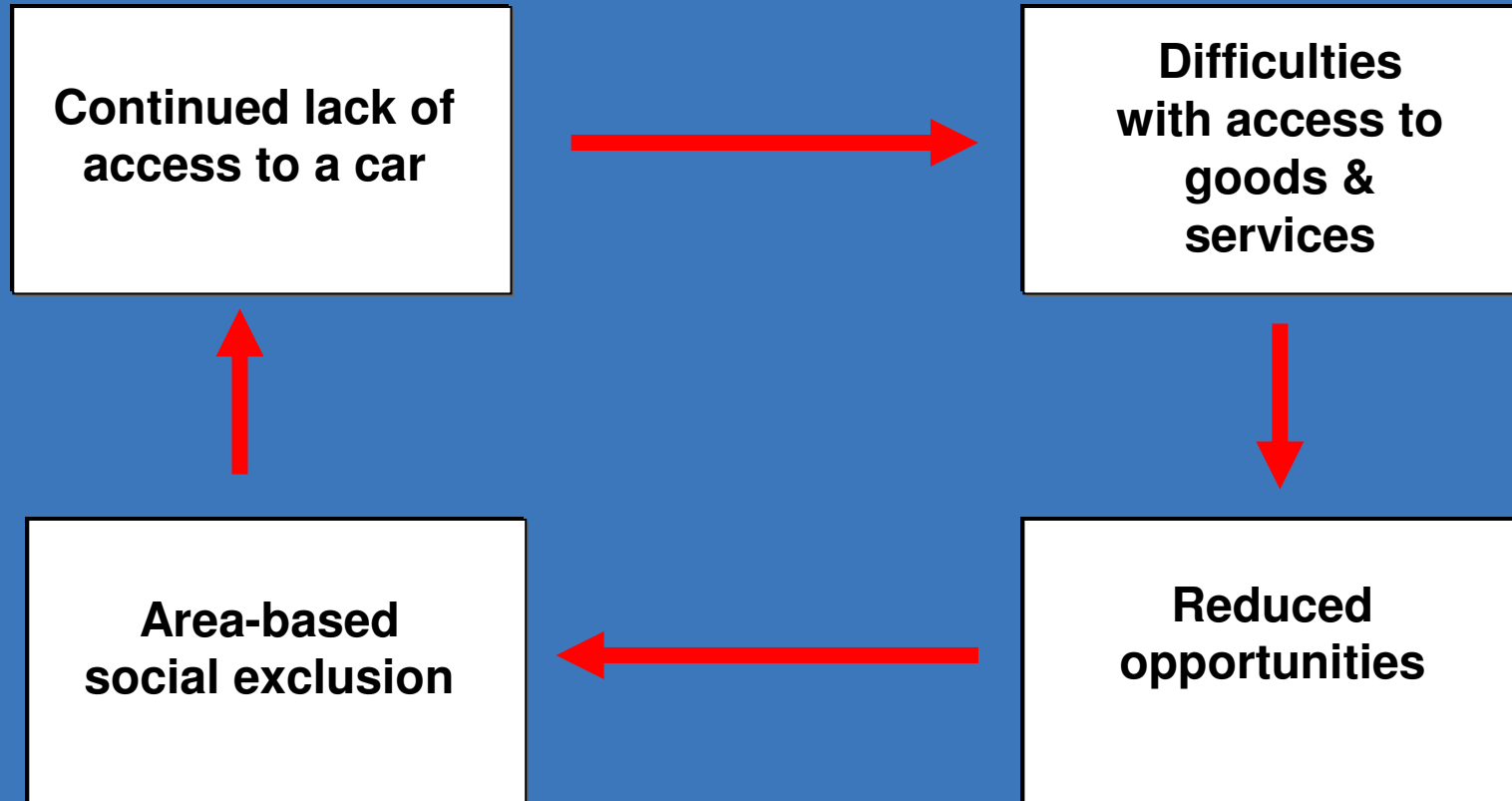
Higher percentage in Accession Countries

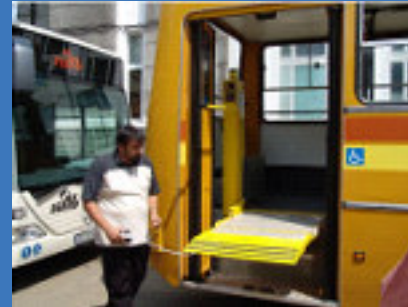
